


Liverpool Philharmonic Hall Visual Guide

Welcome to Liverpool Philharmonic Hall

- We are a concert hall that has a wide range of music, comedy, film and family events.
- This is what the building looks like from the outside at the front.
- This is the main entrance of Liverpool Philharmonic Hall, on Hope Street.








Inside The Hall

 When you enter through the doors, you will see a big space in front of you. This is called the Foyer.

• If you turn to your left, you will see the **Box Office**, where tickets are sold. If you look right, you will see a **seating area** with chairs and tables.





Toilets

- There are accessible toilets opposite the seating area.
- There are more toilets downstairs through the seating area, and up by the Grand Circle. You can get to them using the stairs or the lift. Follow the signs for the toilet.
- You can use the toilets at any point before, during or after the concert.



The Auditorium

- When you enter the Auditorium, you will see a big stage full of chairs, music stands and some instruments.
- Once you have found your seats, make sure you're comfortable. A steward will help you find your seat.
- Sometimes you might see a member of staff walk on stage to move a chair or music stand. They are making sure that everything is ready for the concert to begin.









The Concert

- The Orchestra will start to make their way on stage. They might not all come on at the same time.
- They might start playing their instrument before the concert starts. This is so they can warm up.
- The conductor will then walk onto the stage. You might hear some people clap and cheer.
 You can join in if you wish.





The Concert

- When the piece finishes, the audience may clap and you can join in if you want to. The musicians might stand up sometimes, and some people might bow while you are clapping.
- During the performance you might also hear other people in the audience cheer or shout out. You can join in if you want to.



Take A Break

• If during the show, you want to take some time out, we do have some quiet spaces around the venue which you can visit at any time, including the Grand Foyer Bar and Seating Area on the ground floor.

 Let a steward know that you would like to leave, and they will be show you to one of these spaces. You can return to the performance when you feel ready.

• If you would like to bring ear defenders and/or small and quiet sensory/fidget items, you are very welcome to. Please note that we don't have any at Liverpool Philharmonic Hall that you can borrow.



After The Concert

- At the end of the concert, we will go back into the Foyer, and exit through the same door that you came in.
- There is no rush to leave, you can take your time.
